



Fellowship in Surgical and Dental Sleep Medicine at the University Health Network in Toronto, Canada.

This is a one-year comprehensive fellowship in surgical and dental management of sleep breathing disorders and facial deformities at the Toronto Rehab Institute within the University Health Network, a world class teaching hospital in Toronto, Canada.

This is a salaried position commencing July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024; Candidates must be Canadian or American Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery trained and are required to hold a certificate of registration from the Royal College of Dental Surgeons of Ontario (RCDSO). ABOMS or FRCDC preferred but not required.

This fellowship is based on a 5 days/week curriculum with an opportunity for one-on-one mentorship with Dr. Tina Meisami. There will be minimal emergency call coverage. The aim of the Fellowship in surgical and dental sleep medicine is to provide trainees with the clinical education and surgical experience necessary to develop understanding and expertise in providing treatment for obstructive sleep apnea (OSA) and snoring. Particular focus is placed whereby treatment of OSA will have a profound impact

Fellows will develop expertise in assessing and providing surgical and non-surgical management for patients with sleep breathing disorders, the diagnosis and management of complications following maxillomandibular advancement surgery (MMA) and mandibular advancement device (MAD) therapy, and cross-disciplinary treatment of OSA with sub-specialities in sleep medicine, from Respirology, Otolaryngology, Neurology and Psychiatry. Clinical and translational research will also be a vital component of the fellowship, with dedicated research time centered around clinical decision making and quality improvement.
